Context of the Programme

- The programme aimed at creating awareness among the participants about cyber crimes such as hacking, uploading obscene content on the internet, hacking into a person's e-banking account to withdraw money etc.
- It also aimed at learning the various ways of getting control over the increasing cases of cyber crime and ways of preventing oneself from being a victim of such crimes

The Programme

- The programme was held in the Golden Hall of The College and 150 students from the Department of Political Science and English including six faculty members participated in it.
- The resource person explained how cyber crime has become one of the most threatening and challenging problems for law enforcement, judicial system and the public. While explaining the different types of cyber crime, the resource person shared his own experiences, a number of cyber crime cases he has dealt in the past and also gave suggestions on how one can safeguard himself while using internet and social media
