The workshop aims to create an avenue for students to learn different sets of soft skills namely, simple account keeping, basic interview skills, manners and etiquettes, etc

The Programme

- The programme was an online training programme. It was conceptualized in such a way that students were able to attend it without disrupting their normal classes
- The training was made flexible as per the need of the students in which they were able to interact freely with the resource person and the he was able to ask them about the challenges they face in the classrooms, institutional premises, among peers and in outside environment and cater specifically to such.

Outcome

- While some of the students found the basic account keeping really useful in their day to day lives, others found the basic manners and etiquette skils taught to them useful as they could be used right after the training or even within. Some found it particularly useful as they are to face job interviews right after leaving the college.
- The participants also mentioned that it helped them better understand different cultures and would boost their confidence in the midst of people from outside their own culture
- Most of them agreed that the training all in all boosted their confidence and prepared them to face their future.
