- The seminar was chaired by Mr. Lalenkawla Leader, Weber Club, GHBC. After a brief introduction, Prof. Sanny Tochwawng, Chairperson, Research & Consultancy Cell gave a welcome speech which was followed by a report from the Secretary of the Weber Club, Mr. Lalrempuia, informing the audience about the aims and objectives of the Club.

## Context:

- The one-day seminar on *Perspective for Civil Service Aspirants* was organized with the purpose of providing aspiring civil servants among the students, with valuable insights and guidance in their pursuit of a career in the civil service. The seminar aimed to equip student-participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to navigate the complex and competitive world of civil service examinations.
