The NSS Unit of our college continued to develop the skills and personality of our students (volunteers) through community services. It also tries to inculcate the life's best policy of helping others (NOT ME BUT YOU) in their mind through different activities taken inand outside the college campus, which is the main theme of the National Service Scheme. Our Unit have adopted villages around Aizawl city like Muthi village, Sailam village, Hualngohmun Village and Tachhip village. The various activities and programmes undertaken during the reported period may briefly be highlighted as below-

- ADOPTED VILLAGE SIGNBOARD PLANTED: Signboards was planted along side of the entrance road for Tachhip and Hualngohmun villages for showing our NSS Unit adopted villages on 17th May, 2018.
- 2. SPECIAL CAMPING HELD AT TWO DIFFERENT VILLAGES: Special Camping were organised at two different places as mentioned below such as First at Durtlang Venglai during 16th 22nd April, 2018, constructed Public Urinal which is also located near to our college Women's Hostel. Secondly, our unit organised two special camping at Sailam Village, constructed Public Concrete Steps jointly by two units at the same place near Govt. Middle School, Sailam during 1st 7th June, 2018.
- OBSERVATION OF GREEN MIZORAM DAY: On 11th June, 2018 Green Mizoram Day was observed by our unit along with the whole of Mizoram by clearing and refercing our plantation site at Hmuifang road near Thiak village under the rainy conditions of weather.
- PLANTATION OF FLOWERING TREES AT SIHHMUI: Planting of flowering trees (Saron) at Lengpui Airport road (Sihhmui area) was done on 6th July, 2018 in collaboration with Tourism Dept., Govt. of Mizoram.
 BLOOD DONATION CAMP HELD THREE TIMES: Voluntary Blood Donation
- 5. BLOOD DONATION CAMP HELD THREE TIMES: Voluntary Blood Donation camp was organised thrice during the reported period at the college Golden Hall on 18th July, 2018, 1st October, 2018 and 5th February, 2019. The total units of blood donated for the three campswas 658 units (270 units of blood from 208 males and 62 females for the first, 200 units of blood from 134 males and 66 females for the second time and 188 units of blood from 116 males and 72 females for the third time).








